

How to find us

RAIL

- Kings Cross and • Euston – take the southbound Victoria line to Oxford Circus station and follow the directions below.
- Paddington - take the southbound Bakerloo line to Oxford Circus station and follow the directions below.
- Victoria - take the northbound Victoria line to Oxford Circus station and follow the directions below.
- Waterloo and • London Bridge - take the westbound (northbound) Jubilee line to Bond Street station and follow the directions below.
- Liverpool Street - take the westbound Central line to Bond Street station and follow the directions below

UNDERGROUND

- Bond Street (Jubilee and Central lines), exit the station onto Oxford Street and walk east (towards the Debenhams Store) along Oxford Street. At the far corner of Debenhams turn left onto Vere Street and at the end of Vere Street turn right onto Henrietta Place and then immediately left onto Wimpole Street. Walk up Wimpole Street, cross the junction with Wigmore Street and we are the second door on the left immediately after the junction with Queen Anne Street.
- Oxford Circus (Central, Bakerloo and Victoria lines), exit via the Oxford Street/Regent Street exit and walk west along Oxford Street until you reach Vere Street on your right hand side. Turn right onto Vere Street and at the end of Vere Street turn right onto Henrietta Place and then immediately left onto Wimpole Street. Walk up Wimpole Street, cross the junction with Wigmore Street and we are the second door on the left immediately after the junction with Queen Anne Street.
- Baker Street (Jubilee, Bakerloo, Circle, Metropolitan, and Hammersmith & City lines), exit onto Marylebone Road and walk east (towards the green domed 'Planetarium'). Cross the Marylebone Road at the crossing just before the Planetarium and continue walking east until you reach Devonshire Place on your right. Turn into Devonshire Place, continuing straight on to Upper Wimpole Street, and at the junction with New Cavendish Street, straight again onto Wimpole Street. We are the last door but one on the right immediately before the junction with Queen Anne Street.

BUS

The closest bus stops are Bond Street (Bond Street) and Soho (Oxford Circus). Buses serve these bus stops directly from Waterloo (numbers 139 and 176), Paddington (numbers 7, 15 and 23), Euston (numbers 10, 73, and 390), Liverpool Street (number 23) and Victoria (number 73).

CAR

If you are driving to Camerons, the area to the South of Marylebone Road is inside the congestion charging zone, so you will need to pay accordingly. There are plenty of parking meters ('pay by mobile phone') in the area along Wimpole Street and the nearby roads and NCP car park in Cavendish Square.

TAXI

Camerons is only a short drive from most of the main central London stations. When giving our address to the taxi driver, explain that Camerons is the second door on the left, immediately after the junction with Queen Anne Street.
